


DIRECTIONS:

- Print pages 2 through 14 using cardstock or paper. Page 4 is the cover page and page 2 is the last page. Print everything in LANDSCAPE.
- Laminate page 2 through 14.
- Cut on the dotted lines on pages 4 through 14. Affix <u>rough</u> Velcro to pages 5 through 14 where indicated. Cut out each colored square on page 3 and affix <u>soft</u> Velcro to the backs.
- Leave page 2 whole (do not cut in half) and affix rough Velcro on each square. This will be
 the last page of the book and will extend out 1/3 longer than the others. Attach your
 colored square pieces here.
- You can now assemble the book by using a binder comb, staples, or a binder ring(s) on the left edge of all pages allowing it to flip open to the left with the square pieces on the last page visible side by side of the smaller pages as shown on the cover page.
- To use with a student: Square pieces on the right should be visible to the student. Read the sentence. Model the core word, MAKE, on the student's communication device or big core board. Student removes the indicated piece and places it on the page.






Cut out these squares leaving the black border and affix <u>soft</u> Velcro to the backs.










